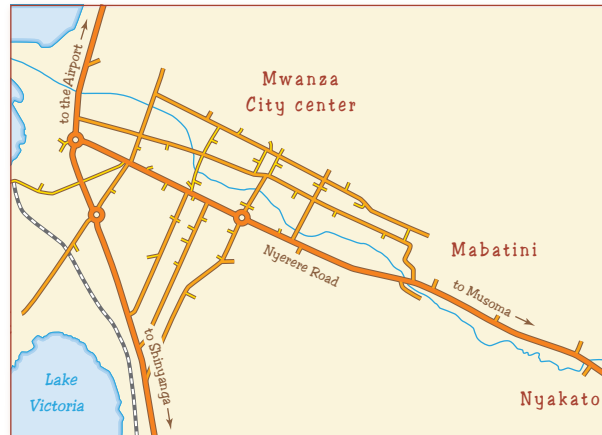

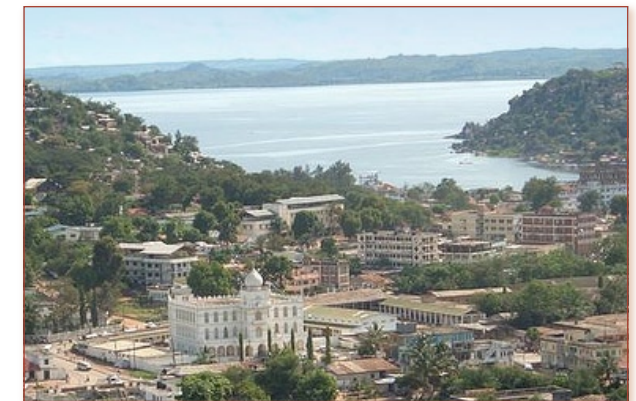
### Enjoy your stay in Mwanza with us

### 2-Room-Apartments

## Cultural Tourism in Lake Victoria Region

### Bujora Cultural Center & Sukuma Museum

Visit the Sukuma museum in Kisesa and take part in dance and drum performances. On every Sunday you can participate in the prayers of the Catholic Church at the museum.

### Traditional Healer

Let yourself be introduced to a traditional healer and his ancient knowledge about herbs.

### Lake Victoria Tour

You can go to fish with the fishermen in their traditional boats. Through the tour you will be able to find out more about the sensitive and ecological system of the lake.

### Village Excursion

Village excursions give you an insight into the rich cultural heritage. You will learn about the traditional values and family structures. Visit a school or listen to a story teller. Watch the women while they weave carpets and baskets and learn how to cook the staple meals.



## Safaris in the neighbourhood

### Saa Nane Island

Only 10 minutes from Mwanza City you can reach the little Island Saa Nane, where you can have a relaxing day and observe a lot of birds.

### Ukerewe Island

Make an excursion to the fertile and exciting Ukerewe Island, to trace the tracks of the cultural and historical writer Aniceti Kitereza.

### Serengeti & Ngorongoro Crater

Make a Safari to the famous Serengeti National Park, only 2 hours drive from Mwanza City. The wide open savannah, with the huge amount of game, inspires even experienced Africa travellers over and over again. The annual migration of millions of gnus, zebras and gazelles offers an incomparable spectacle. Adjacent to the Serengeti you can visit the Ngorongoro Crater. No other region offers such an awesome biodiversity of species in such a narrow space.
